# WHAT DOES MOWER COUNTY EMPLOYEES CREDIT UNION (MCECU) DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

## Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

### What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and Transaction history
- Account balances

and Payment history

Credit history

and Checking account information

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

#### How?

All financial companies need to share **members'** personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their **members'** personal information; the reasons **Mower County Employees** chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Definitions Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  Mower County Employees Credit Union has no affiliates	
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  Mower County Employees Credit Union does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.	
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.  Mower County Employees Credit Union doesn't jointly market
